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Introduction

Local Government Week is designed to showcase the work councils do in their communities, including the wide variety of services they provide. Local Government Week in 2024 will run from Monday 29 July-Sunday 4 August.

The week aims to help move the conversation beyond roads, rates and rubbish, to the important and farreaching role councils play as the hubs of their communities.

As a sector we are responsible for pools, parks and playgrounds, libraries, local festivals and lighting, cemeteries, childcare centres and community infrastructure. We employ lawyers, labourers and librarians, cleaners, carpenters and carers, electricians, engineers and educators. Councils are a reflection of the complex communities they serve day in and day out.

Key message samples to use in your marketing

- As the level of government closest to communities, councils are best placed to activate healthy local economies and thriving neighbourhoods.
- Partnerships across all levels of government can help NSW build back better in the wake of bushfires, floods, and the cost-of-living crisis.
- Local Government Week celebrates the range and diversity of services councils offer the community: everything
 from community events, childcare centres, libraries, sports fields, parks, and cemeteries, to food safety checks,
 building and development and pet registration.

Council Specific Messages

Customise the below messages specific to your council

- [COUNCIL] is staffed and run by local people, for local people. (Personalise where possible. Use pics of council staff at work).
- [COUNCIL] promotes local business and attracts investment to our community. (Again, personalise where possible.

 Use pics of local businesspeople, shoppers, etc.)
- [COUNCIL] works with business and the wider community to promote a healthy local economy and create local jobs.
- [COUNCIL] is part of your everyday. (Where possible, include stats, e.g. info about environmental programs, recycling, number of parks, etc.)
- [COUNCIL] provides recycling services to manage chemicals and e-waste, green waste and food scraps, as well as glass, metals, paper, and cardboard.
- [COUNCIL] works to make your neighbourhood accessible; on foot, by bike, or by car.





FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS TO DOWNLOAD THE DIGITAL ASSETS TO CUSTOMISE FOR YOUR COUNCIL ACTIVITIES.

- **STEP 1** Choose a digital asset kit to download. We have provided the resources in Adobe InDesign files and non-Adobe InDesign files to suit any level of photo editing capabilities.
- **STEP 2** Check your download folder for the resources and move it to a personal folder or onto your desktop for easy access.
- Open the selected resources in either Adobe InDesign or PowerPoint to customise with your council's logo, images and text. Click save.
- **STEP 4** You can use the assets provided within this pack to help write a post to go with the image.

Local Government in NSW • Did you know?

- Councils deliver so much more than roads, rates, and rubbish: they are a reflection of the complex communities they serve each and every day.
- Councils in NSW look after more than \$178 billion of community assets parks, pools and playgrounds, libraries, local festivals and lighting, cemeteries and childcare centres, museums and art galleries.
- Councils employ more than 50,000 people in local communities right across NSW.
- Councils are helping to drive a locally led economy by employing lawyers, labourers and librarians, cleaners, carpenters and carers, electricians, engineers and educators.
- Local government in NSW manages 90% (164,000km) of the state's local and regional road network.
- Local government spends more than \$2 billion each year on caring for the environment via recycling and waste management, stormwater management and preserving and protecting native flora and fauna.
- NSW has 450 council-run libraries that attract more than 34.8 million visits each year.
- NSW councils manage an estimated 35 million tonnes of waste each year.

Council Stall

Take your message to the people

If your area has regular markets or a major shopping centre, set up a stall to promote the services of the council and undertake community outreach and engagement. Staff could take photos for your council's social media pages



Libraries and Museums

Demonstrate your unique community

Hold photographic exhibitions, story time for children or run special exhibitions, or something else unique to your area.



Free History Tours

Profile people and places

Host a free community history tour and promote it to your Rotary, Lions, Apex, Probus and other service clubs. Or offer to join meetings and make presentations on council activities.



Free Talks

Conduct free talks on topics of interest in your community such as sustainable living, waste recycling, traffic management, bushland regeneration or animal licences. Ask staff who manage these functions within council to suggest venues and speakers.



Town Meeting

Hold a town meeting and invite the community to find out about what your council is doing.



Mock Council Meeting

Hold a mock council meeting and invite school students to participate as councillors so they can see how meetings are run.



Free Pet Microchipping

Hold a free pet microchipping day in your area.



Tour of Local Facilities for Schoolchildren

Organise a tour of community services and council facilities – for example, of water treatment facilities, animal shelters, community care and local libraries.



Local Sports Day

Invite local sports teams/clubs to one location to promote their sport. This could be hosted at one of the sports grounds run by council. Allow areas for children to try different activities and parents/guardians to talk to the organisers. Feature your council and display Local Government Week posters.





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Launch an Invite

Local Government Week is the perfect springboard to launch a community initiative/program – particularly if it is something unique to your local area.



Presentation of SES Award

Hold an event to present State Emergency Service (SES) awards in your local area.



Meet The Councillors

Hold a session where residents can meet your councillors, either in council chambers or out in the community such as at the local shopping centre or town square.



Create a Postcard Competition

Send postcard templates to local schools and ask students to draw something they love about their community. On the other side of the postcard they could write why they love it or a thank you letter to someone at council (e.g. garbage collectors, groundskeeper etc.) for something they appreciate. The postcards could be exhibited by the council, collated into a publication or website, shared on social media or produced by the council for sale or promotion.



Gardening Competition

Invite participants to publish pictures of their gardens on Facebook/Instagram or send the mayor to entrants' homes during Local Government Week.

Sample Marketing Content Plan

DAY 1

MEDIA RELEASE

Interview with Mayor to celebrate the week and highlight what your council has delivered in the past year for the community.

SOCIAL POST

Celebrate your council wins. Share a good news story using one of our customisable social posts or gif.

DAY 2

NEWSLETTER

Issue a special release Local Government Week theme newsletter to your community network to share and celebrate the wins your council has delivered over the past year.

SOCIAL POST

Competition time! Run a competition to engage your community to enter and share feedback.

DAY 3

COMMUNITY EVENT/ACTIVITY

Host an event or activity to engage with your community in the week.
