The awards have a dedicated marketing campaign with website editorial, email campaigns, promotion to the online Events Network and through The Weekly newsletter, and media releases alerting a widespread community.

The **RH Dougherty Events and Communications**

Awards promote excellence in communication within Local Government. The RH Dougherty Awards aim to recognise and encourage greater understanding and accountability by councils to their communities. The importance of building a partnership between community and council has been acknowledged by local government and consultation and two-way communication are taking place all the time. There are four sections:

- Reporting to your Community
- Excellence in Communication
- Innovation in Special Events
- Outstanding Individual Contribution.

The **Leo Kelly OAM Arts and Culture Awards** celebrate outstanding achievement by local government organisations in strategic planning for arts and culture. The awards seek to recognise councils that are leaders in arts and culture and have excelled in strategic policy, planning, delivery and evaluation. This includes integrated cultural planning and policy, creative stakeholder engagement, building capacity of the arts and cultural sector.

This award is in honour of the late Cr Leo Kelly OAM – a passionate and dedicated LGNSW Board member, long-serving Blacktown City Councillor and champion for the arts, who passed away in January 2017.

The **LGNSW Planning Awards** recognise councils that have demonstrated excellence in planning and development services. The awards focus on leadership and culture change, innovation and excellence, recognising actions to promote cooperation, participation and the delivery of positive and pragmatic outcomes in the planning and development area.

Pat Dixon Memorial Scholarship

The late Cr Pat Dixon was the first Aboriginal woman elected to local government in Australia and worked tirelessly for the community she represented.

In recognition of her service and achievements in local government, a scholarship has been established for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander councillors and council staff members in NSW to undertake further study, professional development or research.

The scholarship is administered by LGNSW and recipients are determined by four trustees.
