

Building Resilience to Climate Change

Round 1

Building Resilience to Climate Change (BRCC) is a partnership between the NSW Office of Environment and Heritage and Local Government NSW and is co-funded by the NSW Environmental Trust. BRCC assists NSW Local Government address recognised climate change risks and vulnerabilities to build resilience to future extreme climatic events and hazards.

Applications have been assessed and grants awarded to councils for projects to be delivered in 2015. A total of \$432,500 was distributed across 6 projects around NSW.
