NSW OLG is preparing regulations...

- Councils are to develop an induction program for newly elected and returning councillors and a specialised supplementary program for the Mayor within six months of their election.
- Councils are to develop an ongoing professional development program for the Mayor and each Councillor.
- Councils are to determine the content of the induction and ongoing professional development programs in consultation with the Mayor and each Councillor and with the governing body as a whole.
- Councils are to annually report details of the content of the induction and ongoing professional development training
