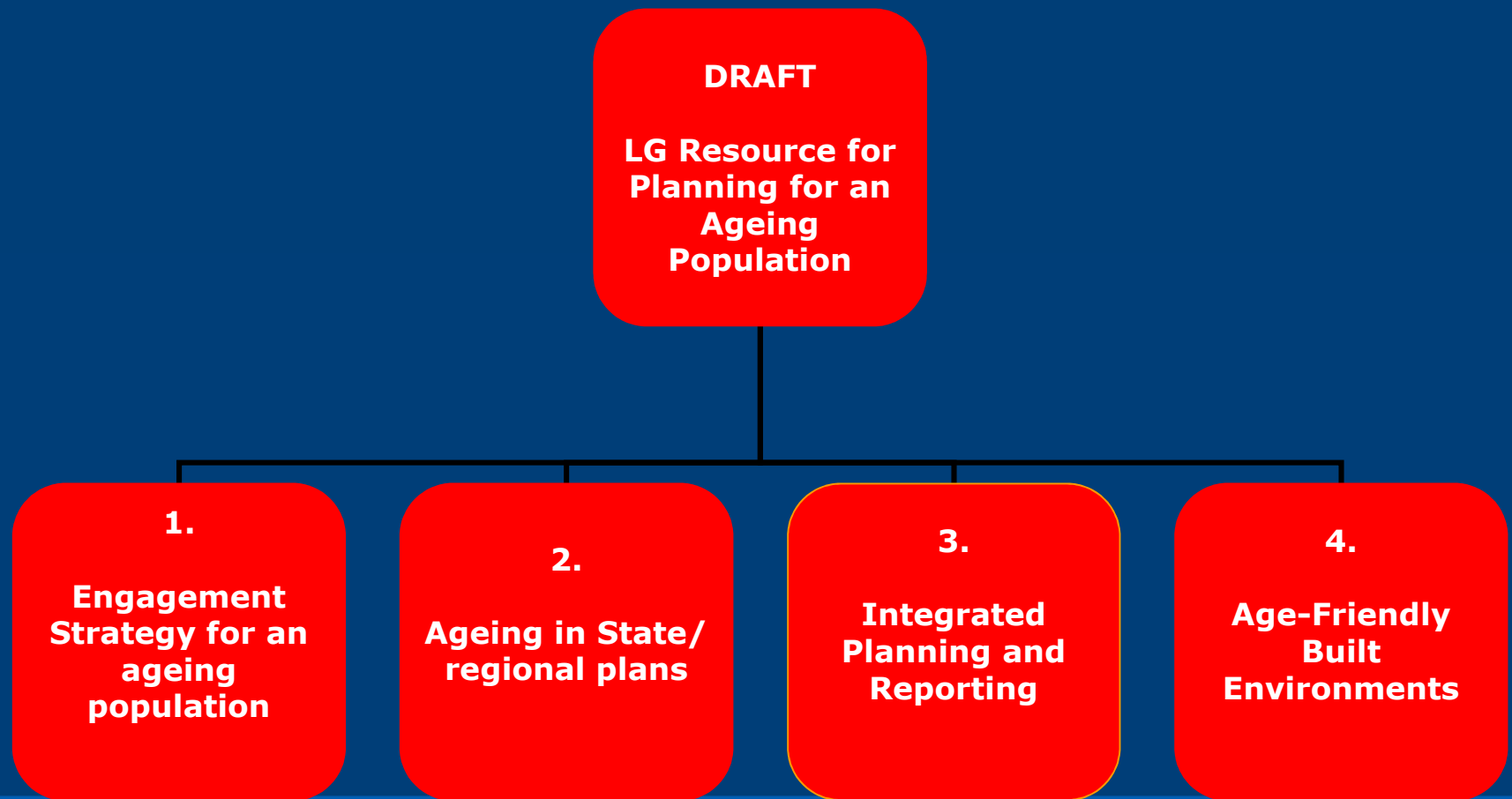


Aim

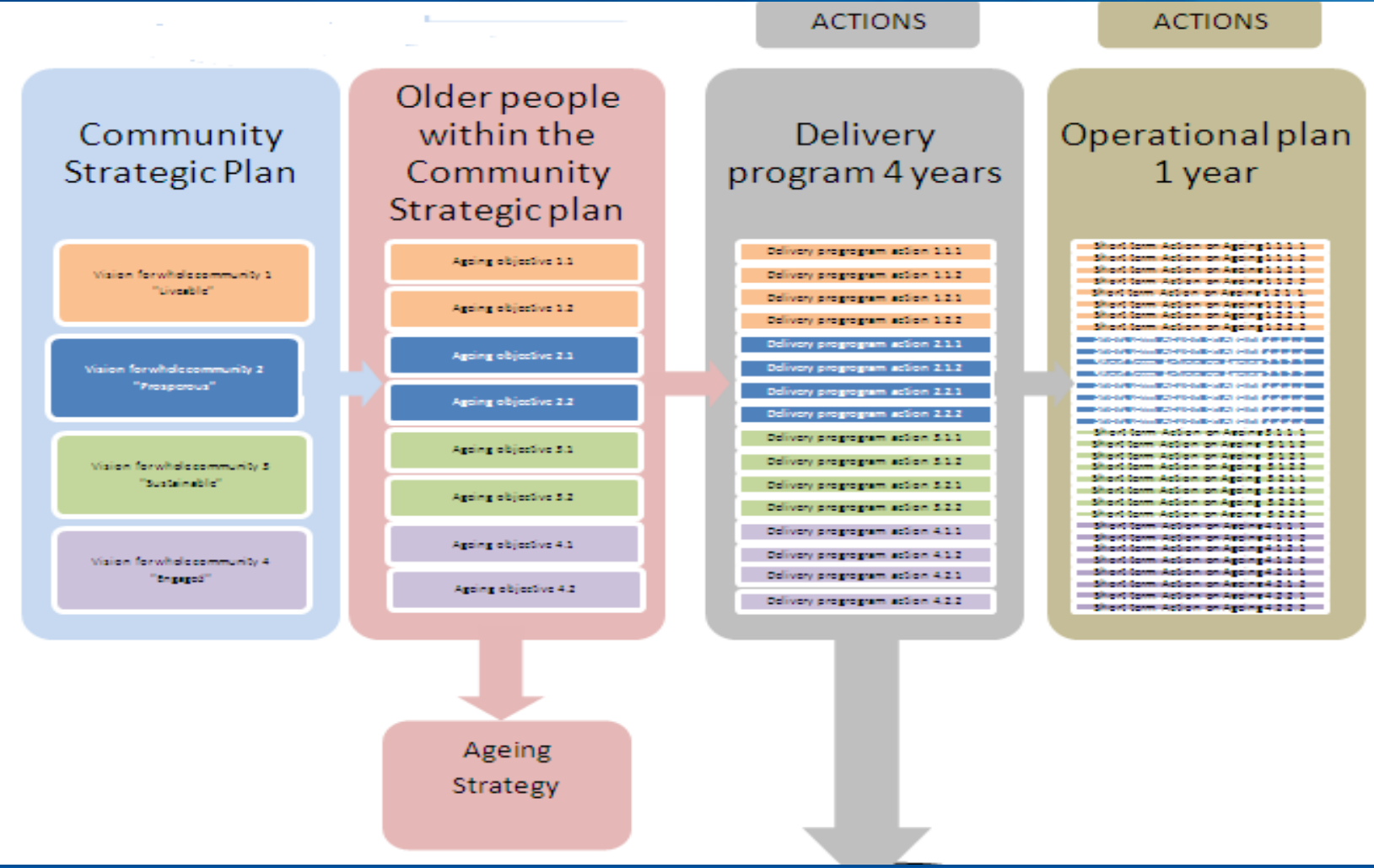


2. State and regional plans
